

The Cheesy Chick Food Truck Policies:

Before Event:

- If you need to be added to our insurance, please let us know at least 1 week prior with the exact wording and requests from your company.
- We may need a local permit for your location/event. If we do not have the permit we may charge you the permit fee.
- If we are on private property, but you do not own it, we would need written consent to be on the owner's property.
- All events are now weather pending. For example if it is raining, thundering or lightning in excess of more than 2 hours of event, or ½ of the event time we will cancel.
- We will be on site at least 30 minutes prior to scheduled start time. We may come earlier or a bit later pending our schedule, length of event, and amount of expected persons to be served.
- We reserve the right to not be on site 30 minutes prior and to possibly open no later than 15 minutes after scheduled start time.
- If the truck breaks down, we will notify you via email and phone ASAP. We will do our best to accommodate when possible.

Day of Event:

- We will not park in any handicap spot or handicap noted no parking zone. We will also not block handicap sidewalk ramps, unless the parking lot is closed off to traffic/not in use.
- We will not park next to or around a fire hydrant. We will not park in fire zones, unless again parking lot is closed to traffic.
- We need at least 3 car spots sectioned off to park. We must park at least 10 feet away from each food truck.
- We ask to have our parking spot coned off, sectioned off etc prior to arrival. Please provide us with a map or detailed directions of parking.
- We will not park on dirt, gravel or land spots during rain storms, or if the ground is visibly wet.
- We can not serve customers in the flow of traffic, our service window must be facing away from traffic.
- If any of these policies are not followed, or we are asked to break state, local or federal laws we will leave the event.

Minimums:

- Any job/location in Grand Island or beyond has at least a 500 dollar minimum for 2 hours of service.
- Any job/location in Blasdell or beyond has at least a 500 dollar minimum for 2 hours of service.
- Friday night events have a 500 dollar minimum, Saturday day has a 700 dollar minimum, Saturday night has a 1,000 dollar minimum (after 8pm), Sunday's have a 1,000 dollar minimum. (These minimums maybe more or less pending truck availability, schedule and location.)

FAQ:

- We can be on site for 30 minutes, 2 hours, 3 hours or more!
- Yes the food truck will be on site for lunches, events, and catering.
- Yes we offer corporate catering, private catering, and fundraisers. (we have a fundraiser form that must be filled out prior to event.)
- For every 250 expected persons you should have 1 food truck per.
- We have Gluten Free Bread.
- We have Vegan Cheese.
- We accept cash and cards during service.
- We only accept a check for catering deposits.
- We need a signed contract for catering and minimum jobs before booking.
- All events must be finalized via email.
